To All Registered Motorcycle Owners:

Due to a change to the state vehicle inspection law, motorcycles will no longer be required to submit for an inspection as of August 1, 2010. If your motorcycle is due for inspection in the month of August 1, 2010 or later, you do not have to visit a vehicle inspection station. You must also remove the motorcycle registration decal from your license plate.

Please remember that it is your responsibility to keep your bike well maintained and free of defects to ensure the safety of you and others sharing the road. You may be cited by law enforcement at any time for mechanical defects or equipment out of compliance.
